YI to Offer Residential Support Services
YI to Begin Serving Clients with Developmental Disabilities

July 14, 2010 -Youth Alternatives Ingraham now offers a support program for people with developmental disabilities. The program will begin with four beds at Bass House in Saco.

The Residential Support Program at Bass House is a comprehensive service that provides 24-hour care and supervision to people with a developmental disability that results in a significant functional limitation in major life activities. The program provides residential care and community inclusion support, which includes health and medical care, behavioral support, personal care, recreation, psychological services, and community integration.

Bob Gauthier, Senior Director for Developmental Disability Services at YI will oversee the program.

Bass House, in Saco, just over the Scarborough border, was formerly a residential treatment facility for boys in state custody.
